



PARTICIPANT GUIDELINES

All participants in the parade are encouraged to read our participant requirements before they attend the event.

- 1) All vehicles that are used to participate in The Star Bikers Toy and Egg Runs should be taxed (where applicable), have a current MOT Test and should be fully road legal.
- 2) All participants in The Star Bikers Toy and Egg Runs should meet the legal requirement for safety equipment.
- 3) All participants will adhere to instructions received from The Police, event co-ordinators and event marshals.
- 4) All children (16 and under) participating in the Run should be under supervision of their responsible adult at **ALL** times.
- 5) Whilst on the parade, all participants must adhere to the speed limit set by the lead vehicle.
- 6) Participants **MUST** give way to Emergency vehicles in a safe and orderly manner, under the direction of the Police and Event Marshals.
- 7) Participants must remain in control of their vehicle at all times and avoid making any sudden breaking manoeuvres or changes of direction.

This means

NO: Excessive speed

NO: Overtaking/undertaking in dangerous manner.

NO: Performing unsafe manoeuvres likely to cause another vehicle to lose temporary control.

NO: Manoeuvres that could be deemed to be stunts, one or more wheels to become airborne (wheelies/stoppies, burnouts). Anybody witnessing this behaviour is asked to make a note of the behaviour, number plate, time and place; video evidence will also be taken into account if taken. Any information or evidence will be passed on to the Police.

- 8) Participants are notified that CCTV and ANPR cameras are in operation for the duration of the run/parade. If any vehicles are found not to be road legal their details will be given to the Police.
- 9) Participants need to be aware of spectators and all other road users at **ALL TIMES**.
- 10) Should participants need to stop at any point during the run/parade, this should be done in a safe manner, taking due care, avoiding any sudden movements and changes of direction and clearly indicating your intention to stop.

The Participant Requirements will be published via social media outlets prior to the event and bikers will be encouraged to read and adhere to them at **ALL TIMES** during the parade for the safety of all.
